

School Land Trust Summary

For the 2019-2020 school year, Hillcrest Elementary received \$38,410 with a carry over of \$4,464 for a total amount of \$48,381 in School Land Trust funding. Hillcrest spent \$38,401 on a partial teacher salary. \$2,901 was paid for technology supplies. \$9,474 was spent on Chromebooks, however, due to COVID-19, Hillcrest has still not received them.

Goal 1:

By the end of the 2019-20 school year, students will increase typical and above growth for K-2nd grade students on Acadience from 61% to 66% using Pathways of Progress in order to ensure all students can access text.

Due to the COVID-19 school dismissal, we were unable to give the end of the year Acadience assessment.

Goal 2:

By the end of the 2019-20 school year, students will show a 5% increase on the RISE ELA summative assessment.

Due to the COVID-19 school dismissal, we were unable to give the end of the year RISE assessment.

Goal 3:

By implementing ChAT and APTT we will be able to ensure that students feel a sense of belonging and will, therefore, increase the percent of students with 90% attendance from 55% to 60% by the end of the 2019-20 school year.

Goal 4:

By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 35% of the students will show proficiency on the RISE assessment.
